

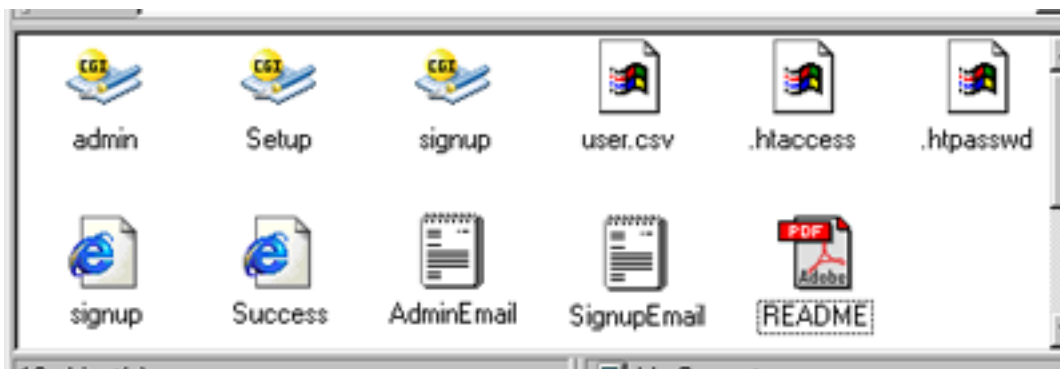
Installation Manual

This installation manual will guide you thru the steps required to Configure and install this Membership Script on your web host. Please make sure that your Server is **Unix/linux** based and Supports **Perl**, **cgi-bin**, and **SendMail** Program.

If you find difficult to install this script, our staff is prepared to install it for you. Please find the contact information at the bottom.

Content of this Package

This package (**Membership.zip**) contains 11 files:



admin.cgi - This Perl Script is your Admin Control Panel

Setup.cgi - Perl Script - Setup/configuration file.

signup.cgi - Perl Script that signup new members to your private site.

user.csv - Database of Members of your Private site.

.htaccess - Prevent unauthorized access to your password protected site.

.htpasswd - Password file

signup.htm - Sign up form template - You can modify the look of sign-up form

Success.htm - Template - The user will be forwarded to this page after account setup

AdminEmail.txt - Email template - The email message sent to the user when you create a membership account manually from Contrl Panel.

SignupEmail.txt - This will be email send to the user when they sign-up themselves

Readme.pdf - This file contains step by step installation details.

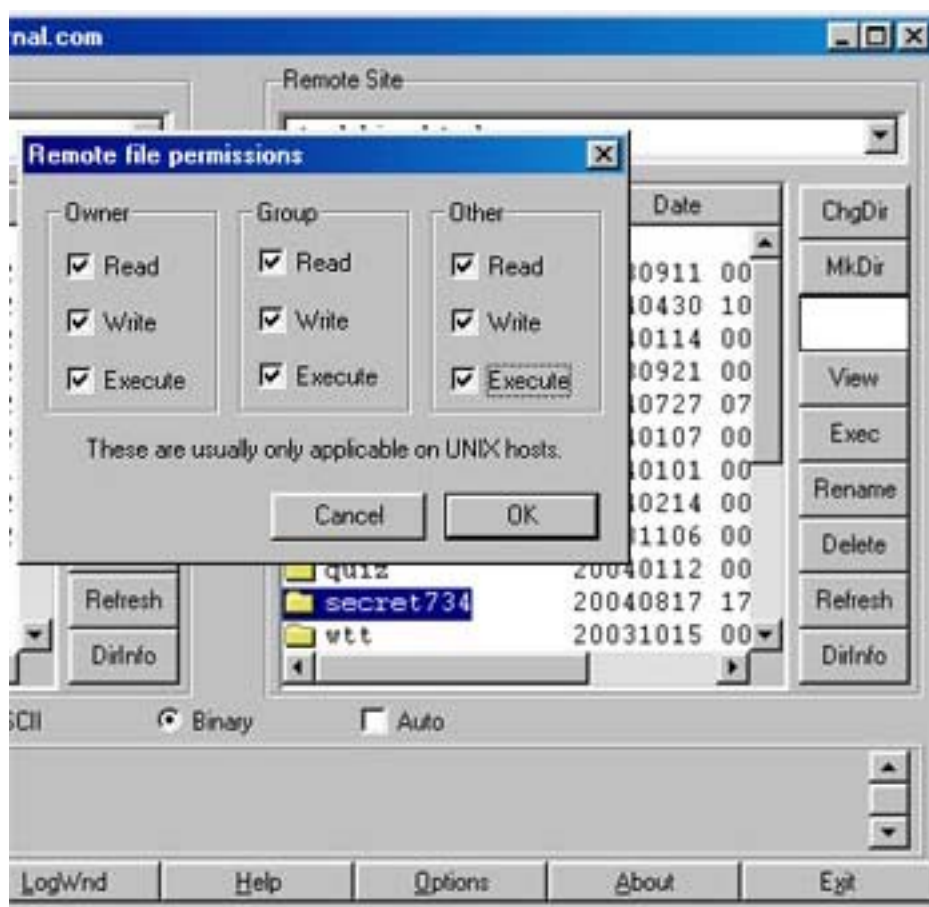
STEP:1 - Create Directories.

You need FTP programs like WS-FTP to follow these steps.

A) Create a 'secret directory' on your website to keep the password file.
You can give any name to this directory, but this will be a name that is difficult to guess. something like 'secret734'

<http://www.YourSite.com/secret734/>

Set CHMOD this directory to '777'



Upload the .htpasswd file coming with the package into this directory in ASCII mode, then set CHMOD to '777'

Now you have to write down the location of The full system path to your password file including the file itself

In my case; its **`/home/public_html/secret734/.htpasswd`**

We need this information later; so write it down or copy and paste into Notepad.

B) Create a directory named 'members' in your Webhost. This will be the password protected directory. The URL of member directory will be;

`http://www.YourSite.com/members/`

Edit the .htaccess file using Notepad, then locate the first line;

`AuthUserFile /home/public_html/secret734/.htpasswd`


You have to replace the path with location of password file in your webhost. (We have already kept this value in the last step. right?)

Save the file and upload it into 'members' directory in ASCII mode.

STEP:2 - Configure Perl Scripts.

Make sure that the location of Perl in your server is:

`#!/usr/bin/perl`

Generally this is the location in ALMOST all servers. The first line of all Perl Scripts (admin.cgi, Setup.cgi and signup.cgi) represents the location of Perl in your webhost. If the default value is correct, you don't have to make any changes, just skip to the next step.

If its different in your case, you have to edit these three Perl Scripts using any text editor like Notepad.

In some cases this may be;

#!/usr/sbin/perl

Or

#!/usr/local/bin/perl

If you are not sure, verify it with your server administrator then make necessary changes. Please don't remove the '#' sign at the beginning.

PS: You don't have to change the default value if the Script works properly. You can skip to next step.

STEP: 3 - Configure the Setup file 'Setup.cgi'


Open this file in Notepad, then make changes to all variables as follows:

Example:1

\$MyName = "Your Name";

Just enter your name within quotes. If my case, I will enter as follows;

\$MyName = "Ali Abdulla";

# setup.cgi

# Your Name.
$MyName = "Ali Abdulla";

# Your Email Address. Please don't remove the \ before @ sign.
$MyEmail = "ali\@promoteindia.com";

# Company / Website Name.
$Company = "Noor Overseas";

# Administration password. Change the default value 'adminpass'. Keep
your Admin pass in a safe place.
$MyAdminPass = "winner";

# Location of membership directory you created
$LoginURL = "http://www.ecommercedealers.com/members/";

# Subject of email message to the user
$AdminEmailSubject = "Welcome to membership site";
```

Example:2

\$Company = "Your Company";

My company name is Noor Overseas, so I will just type;

\$Company = "Noor Overseas";

You have to replace all variable on '**Setup.cgi**' file this way.

Please remember, this is One-Time-Only work and then everything will be automated. Save the changes and skip to the next step.

STEP: 4 - Uploading Files.

Upload the following files into the **cgi-bin** directory in **ASCII** mode.

- **admin.cgi**
- **Setup.cgi**
- **signup.cgi**
- **user.csv**
- **signup.htm**

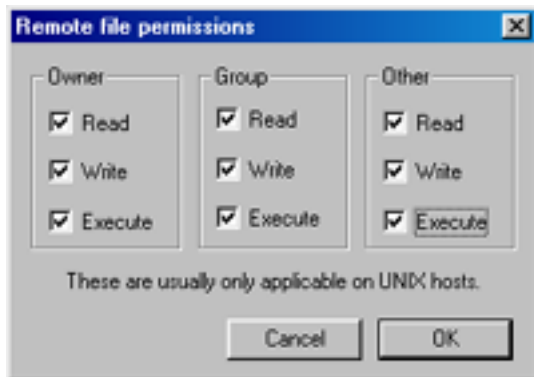
- **Success.htm**
- **AdminEmail.txt**
- **SignupEmail.txt**

DON'T Upload the .htaccess and .htpasswd files to cgi-bin.
We have already uploaded these files in STEP:1

Set CHMOD the Scripts (admin.cgi, Setup.cgi and signup.cgi) to **755**



Set other files to **777**.



Now you are DONE!

STEP: 5 Testing Your Control Panel

Now is the time to test your Admin Control Panel.

Enter the URL of **admin.cgi** file in your browser.

<http://www.YourSite.com/cgi-bin/admin.cgi>

PS: Replace Yoursite.com with your domain name.

The control panel will be appeared as follows.

Please note that you have to enter your Admin Password to use the Control Panel. You can see members list, edit, delete, search and add new account using the control panel. When you create a new account, enter your own name and email address. You will get email notification immediately with login details.

[STEP: 6 - Testing the Sign-up form \(signup.cgi\)](#)

You have to Link this page from ClickBank Control Panel. Set the URL of this script as the URL of 'Thank you page' in ClickBank Control panel as follows.

Note the last part **auth=K34MX780EL** which is very important. You must add a 10-digit code to tell the script that the buyer is coming from

ClickBank after payment. You have to enter the same value given in 'Setup.cgi' file (see the last line).

When the buyer makes payment, this 'Auth Code' will be forwarded to the Script, This system is to protect your Account Sign-up page from unauthorized access.

Example:-

If you give **\$AuthCode = "K34MX780EL"**; in Setup.cgi file you must enter the following URL as thankyou page URL in ClickBank Control Panel:

Now you can make a Zero Dollar order to see how it works.
