

## The Perpetual Traffic Generator™



### Important Readme Information

This is the incredible script that I spent thousands developing so that the Internet Marketer could devote his time to more profitable ventures as opposed to clicking away mindlessly for hours at the computer to get free traffic.

This is THE solution that is completely free of technical problems and messy installations, and so simple that even a monkey can do it.

The following script has up to 44 start pages. Place your startpage and Extra Hits links between the parentheses " ". I have placed the links for the first 3 startpages as an example.

Once that is done, you can either highlight the following from <html> to </html> and paste it into a text editor such as notepad or wordpad and save as text. When the save window opens, change the .txt to .html and you have your start page rotator web page.

Remember to include the .html extension when saving the file.

Your page should be something like myrotator.html

Save this HTML file on your desktop.

All you have to do is launch this page while you are connected, and you're all set.

Absolutely no need for painful server installations and uploading of any sorts!

Now all your start pages should be rotating and you should be racking up thousands of page views to your site.

These are actual people that will view you web site for 20 to 40 seconds at a time. How many products and services you sell will depend greatly on the content of your web site. If you have a killer sales letter, at the beginning of your site, you can potentially be making lots of sales in an hour!

But then again, if you can't sustain the interest of the people

visiting your site, they'll just surf on to another site.

Walk away, and do your important stuff while the traffic is sent to your website, effortlessly.

I highly recommend popup killer. If you can handle the little inconvenience of holding down both the shift and control keys when you connect to the web this is the popup killer to use. You will also have to hold down the shift and control keys for some; not all links that come in your e-mail, but its worth it.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:**

This part of the script: [ setInterval("next\_page();",45000); ] equals 45 seconds. For longer or lesser periods of time, just

change the 45 to the amount of seconds you would like the page to remain before the script rotates to the next page.

Also, if you have less than 44 links you'd need to modify this portion of the Script:

```
Line 59;  
if (page_index == 45)    page_index = 0;
```

Replace the number 45 with x+1, x being the total number of links.

So say you have 22 links only, then you'd replace 45 with 23.

Simple?
